There came on for consideration at a duly constituted meeting of the Mayor and Members of the City Council of the City of Hattiesburg, Mississippi, held on the 6th day of **November, 2018**, the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION 2018-157
CONDEMNATION OF UNSAFE AND DILAPIDATED PROPERTY
Case #1 1705 1st Terrace

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of October 2018 the Council of the City of Hattiesburg, Mississippi, passed a resolution announcing the intention of the City Council to hold a hearing on, the 5th day of November, 2018, in the Council Meeting Room of City Hall in Hattiesburg, Mississippi, as provided by Section 21-19-11 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as annotated and amended, to determine whether or not the following described property is in such a state of uncleanliness as to be a menace to the health and safety of the community, to-wit:

PARCEL: 2-039A-17-015, **1705 1st Terrace HATTIESBURG, MS 39401** and better described as part of Lot 15 and all of Lot 16, Block 2, Forrest Park Subdivision to the City of Hattiesburg, Forrest County Mississippi.

WHEREAS, the owner of the property is: Kristi C. Williamson as Trustee of The Doris Aline Carter Trust

WHEREAS, proper and timely notice of said hearing was given to said parties more than two weeks prior to the date of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing it was determined that the aforementioned property is in such a state of uncleanliness as to be a menace to the health and safety of the community and should be condemned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hattiesburg, Mississippi, as follows:

1. A period of fifteen (15) days shall be extended to the property owner for removal of the violations listed:

Overgrown Lot or Weeds (International Property Maintenance Code, Sec. 302.4)
Open Storage (Land Development Code, Sec. 87)
Vacant Structure (International Property Maintenance Code, Sec. 301.3)

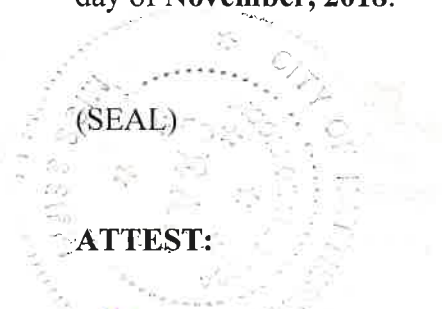
2. If the property owners do not take corrective action within fifteen (15) days to remove the violations, then after a complete and final legal review of the property conducted by the City Attorney, the City will take action to remove all violations listed, said work to be legally contracted with a private contractor or City crews, and the cost of same plus penalty to be certified to the City Clerk for further legal disposition.

3. A copy of this Resolution will be certified and recorded in the Chancery Clerk's Office of Forrest County, Mississippi.

The above and foregoing Resolution, after having been first reduced to writing, was introduced by Council member George, seconded by Council member Delgado, and was adopted by the following vote, to-wit:
