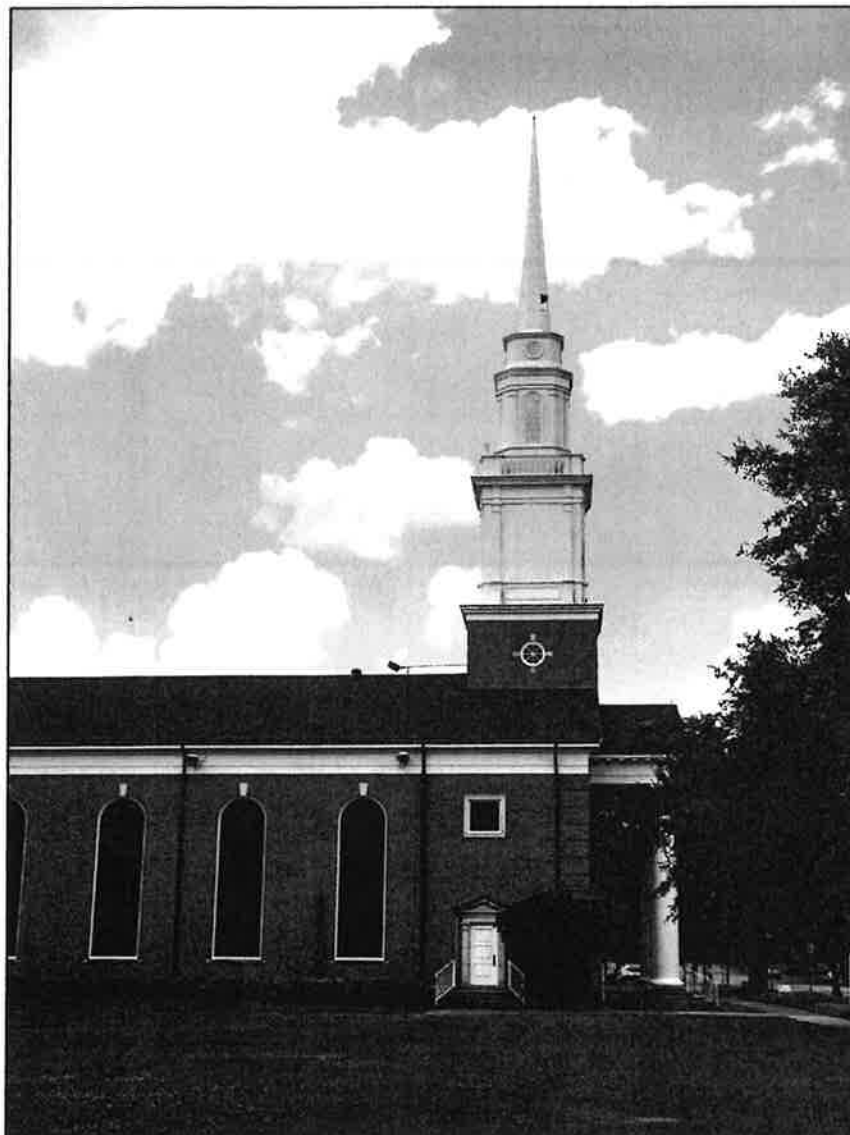

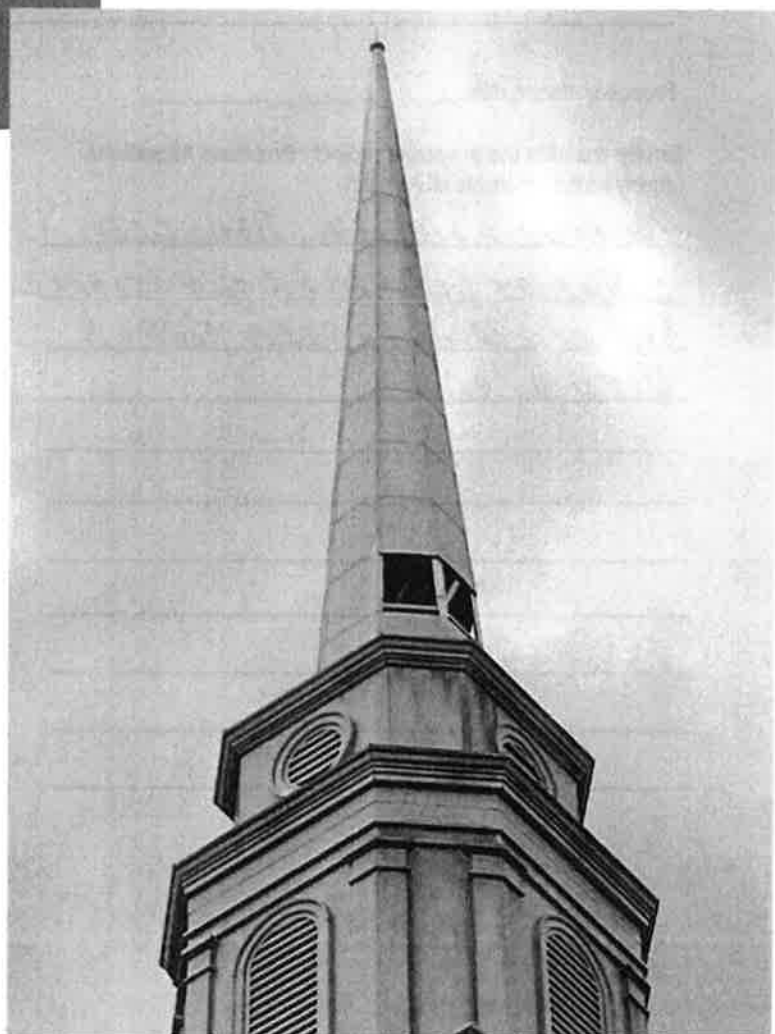

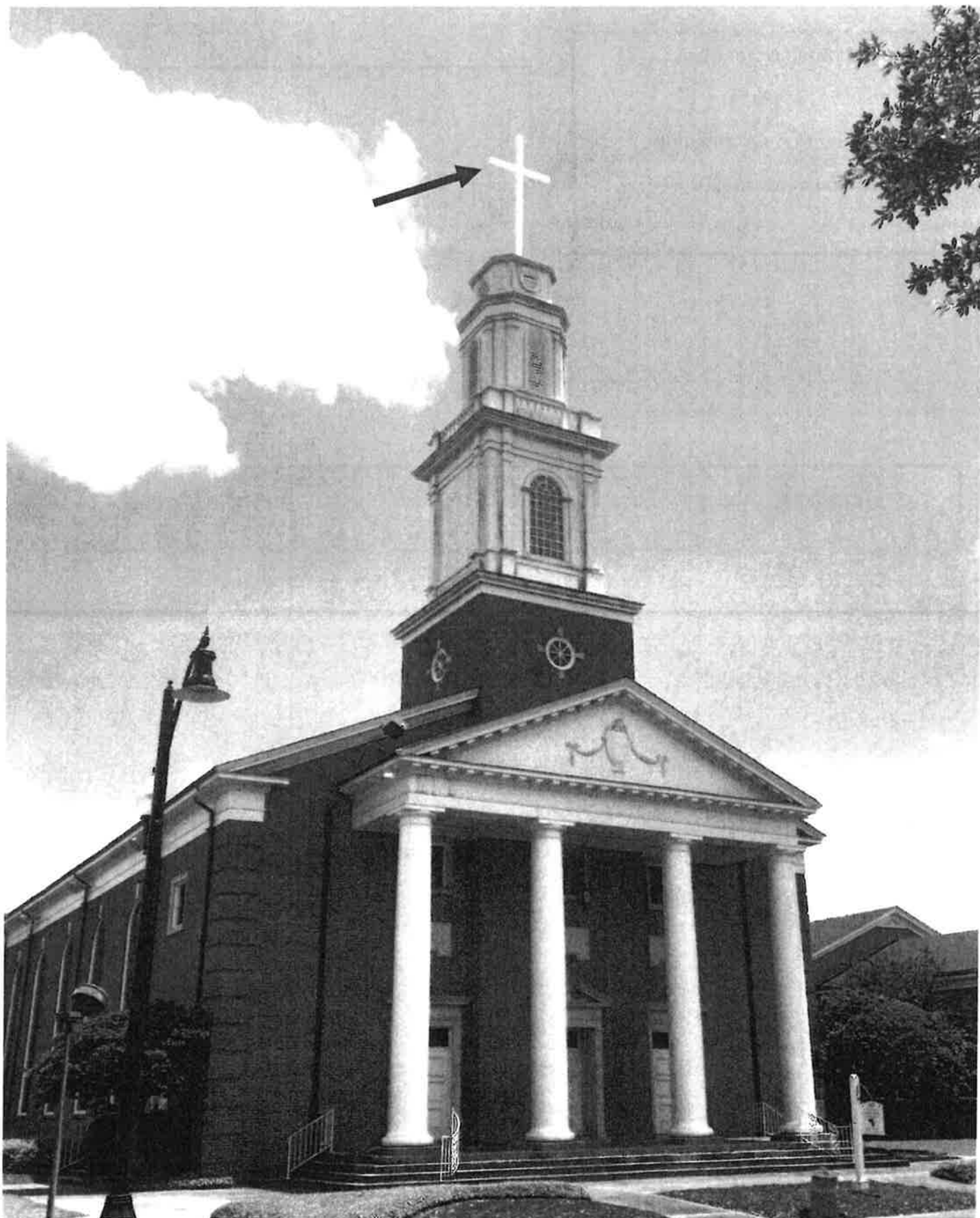

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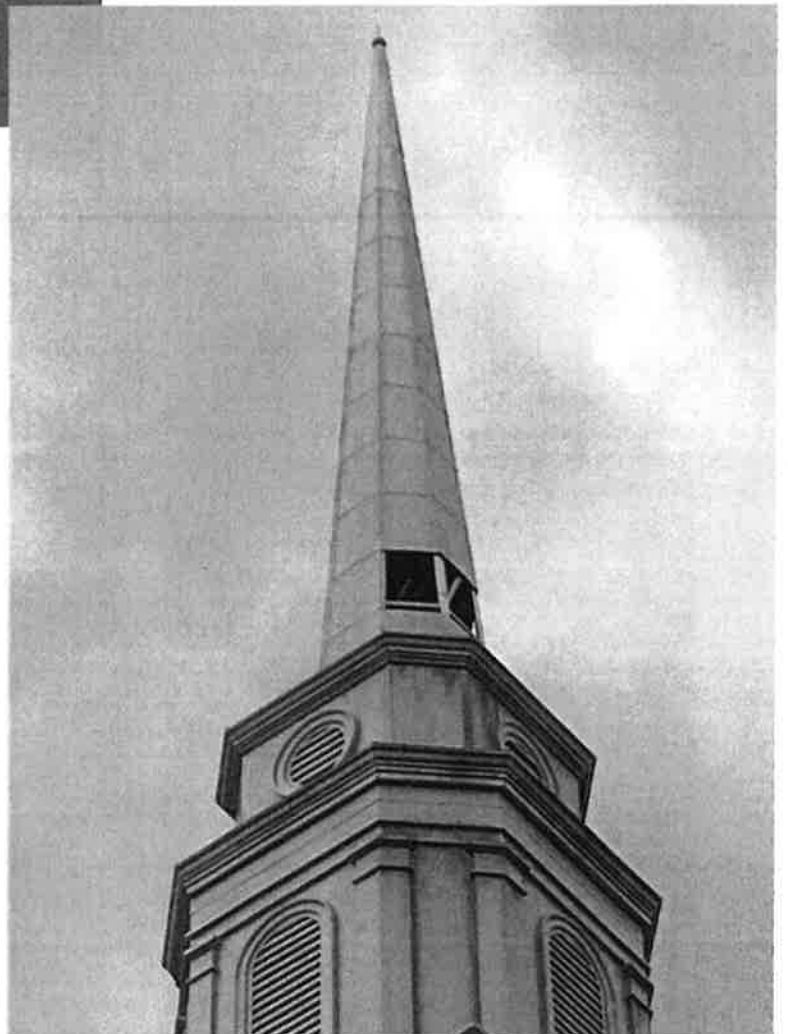
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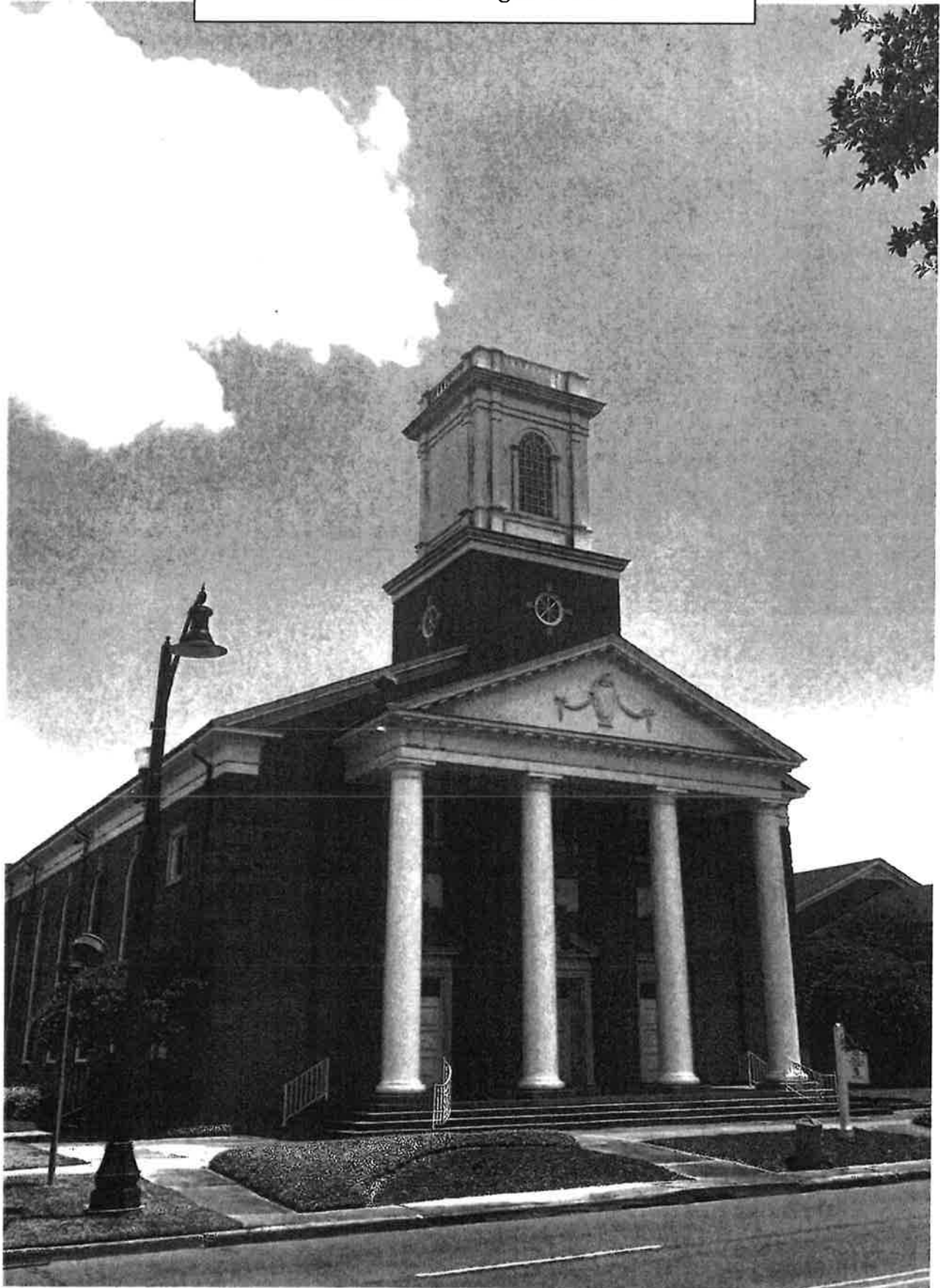


Details of original steeple spire, showing

"Plan 1"

Remove spire and belfry, leave base and seal with new roofing materials.



"Plan 2"

Remove spire only and replace with cross; seal around base of cross with new roofing material.
