RESOLUTION CONDEMNATION OF UNSAFE AND DILAPIDATED PROPERTY Case #7 19 Longino Rd.

McInnis SUBDIVISION of Forrest County, Mississippi, as follows: Beginning at the NE corner of Lot 6, thence run West 720 to and for said point of beginning, thence run South 324'; thence run West 100', thence run North 3324'; thence run East 100'; back to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains 1.7437 acres, more or less.

WHEREAS, proper and timely notice of said hearing was given to said parties more than two weeks prior to the date of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing it was determined that the aforementioned property is in such a state of uncleanliness as to be a menace to the health and safety of the community and should be condemned.

1. A period of fifteen (15) days shall be extended to the property owner for removal of the violations listed:

Unsafe Structure (International Property Maintenance Code, Sec. 108.1.1) Overgrown Lot and Weeds (International Property Maintenance Code, Sec. 302.4)

2. If the property owners do not take corrective action within fifteen (15) days to remove the violations, then after a complete and final legal review of the property conducted by the City Attorney, the City will take action to remove all violations listed, said work to be legally contracted with a private contractor or City crews, and the cost of same plus penalty to be certified to the City Clerk for further legal disposition.
