

There came on for consideration at a duly constituted meeting of the Mayor and Members of the City Council of the City of Hattiesburg, Mississippi, held on the 19th day of February, 2019, the following resolution:

RESOLUTION 2019-68

WHEREAS, Section 17-3-1 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as annotated and amended, provides that the mayor and board of aldermen or board of commissioners of any municipality in the State of Mississippi, may in their discretion, set aside, appropriate and expend moneys, not to exceed one mill of their respective valuation and assessment for the purpose of advertising and bring into favorable notice the opportunities, possibilities and resources of such municipality or county; and,

WHEREAS, the Hattiesburg Alliance for Public Art is a coalition of local citizens who are passionate about making art available to all, free, and a part of everyday life. Composed of artists, business people, tourism officials, and community volunteers, its focus is placed in the power of public art to revitalize a community for its residents and visitors, and to foster greater economic development of the local arts economy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY TH CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HATTIESBURG:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Council of Hattiesburg hereby authorized the expenditure of not to exceed \$10,000.00 for the purpose of advertising and bringing into favorable notice the opportunities, possibilities, and resources of the City of Hattiesburg as authorized by Section 17-3-1 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 as annotated and amended

The above and foregoing Resolution, having been first reduced to writing, was introduced by Council Vice President Dryden, seconded by Council Member George, and adopted by the following vote, to-wit:


